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CLOSED PROGRAMS

Faculty of Medicine	<p>The Medical Doctor Program (MD) is closed to exchange students.</p> <p>The Faculty of Medicine accepts to receive a limited number of exchange applications at the preparatory year (clerkship) for the program leading to the achievement of a medical degree: http://medecine.umontreal.ca/etudes/doctorat-en-medecine/etudiants-visiteurs/.</p> <p>Master's degree - Cellular Biology and Pathology is closed to exchange students.</p> <p>Bachelor and Master programs in Audiology are closed to exchange students.</p> <p>Bachelor's degree – Biomedical Sciences is closed to exchange students.</p> <p>The Master's degree in Orthophony is closed to exchange students.</p>
Faculty of Pharmacy	<p>Ph.D - Pharmaceutical Sciences (Pharm. Ph.D), is not open to exchange students, excluding faculties who have specific agreements with the program.</p>
Faculty of Arts and Sciences	<p>The Department of Communication does not accept exchange students, excluding faculties who have specific agreements with its programs.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Master's degree – Media, Culture and Technology is closed to exchange students. • Master's degree in Journalism is closed to exchange students. • Master's degree - Arts, Creation and Technology is closed to exchange students. • Master's degree – Digital Edition is closed to exchange students. • Master's degree – Social Administration is closed to exchange students. • Bachelor's degree – Political Sciences and Philosophy is closed to exchange students. • Bachelor's degree – Literature and Human Sciences is closed to exchange students. • Master's degree – Physics – plasma option, international path is closed to exchange students. • Master's degree – Medical Physics
Faculty of Continuing Studies	<p>Certificates are continuing studies programs and are not open to international students.</p>
School of Optometry	<p>The Doctor of Optometry Degree (OD) is closed to exchange students.</p>
Faculty of Education	<p>Master's degree in Education- Secondary (281113) is closed to exchange students.</p>

STUDY PROGRAMS WITH PARTICULAR REQUIREMENTS

Faculty of Law

Due to the high number of applications received each year, candidate selection is competitive. Only applicants with an above-average academic record may be selected. Bachelor's degree students must choose their courses from the [list of courses open to international students](#).

Faculty of Environmental Design

School of Architecture	<p>The School of Architecture negotiates in advance with its partners the number of students who can submit applications (only students from universities that are partners with the School of Architecture can apply).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Only those interested in participating in an exchange for a full academic year (September to April) will be considered.• Prospective candidates must include a portfolio.• The School accepts a limited number of students pursuing a Bachelor's degree of Architecture who would like to apply for their third year.• Candidates who present an application for the Master's degree in architecture must have completed at least 4 years of study in their home university.• The number of places in the Master of Architecture is very limited.
School of Design	<p>The School negotiates in advance with its partners the number of students who can submit applications (only students from universities that are partners with the School of Design can apply).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Interior Design and Industrial Design programs are open only in the fall term.• Applications must include a portfolio.• Students in Industrial Design and Interior Design programs must choose their courses by visiting the School's website.• No late application will be accepted after the deadline (April 1st).• Master programs are closed to exchanges students.
School of Urban Planning and Landscape Architecture	<p>The School negotiates in advance with its partners the number of students who can submit applications (only students from universities that are partners with the School of Urban Planning and Landscape Architecture can apply).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The School accepts a limited number of students applying to the Urban Planning Master's degree program.• The School of Urban Planning and Landscape Architecture accepts students applying to the Master's degree only for one term only.• Candidates to Landscape Architecture must provide a portfolio.

Faculty of Dentistry

Only students from Université Catholique de Louvain (Belgium) can apply to the exchange program.

Faculty of Arts and Sciences	
Minor in Arts and Sciences	Students can take a maximum of 2 courses from the same concentration per term.
Department of Political Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students applying to this department, whose first language is not French must submit a French language evaluation according to the Common European Framework which includes their level of written and oral French. • Bachelor's degree in International Studies : exchange students may take a maximum of 1 Law course. • Bachelor's degree in Communication and Politics: exchange students may follow a maximum of 1 Communication course. • Bachelor in Economics and Politics : exchange students must take at least 2 Political Science courses per term.
Master programs in International Studies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students applying to this program whose first language is not French must submit a French language evaluation according to the Common European Framework that includes their level of written and oral French. • Students can take a maximum of one political science course and a maximum of one law course per semester.
Department of Communication	<p>The Department negotiates in advance with its partners the number of students who can submit applications</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only the Bachelor and the Master in communication sciences are open to exchange students. • The number of places to the master's degree in communication is very limited. A good level of English is required.
Department of Demography	Only students currently enrolled in a Bachelor at home university can apply to the Bachelor in Demography.
Department of Art History and Film Studies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exchange students cannot take practical courses that are specific to the Bachelor's of Film Studies degree (117110). Undergraduate candidates only have access to courses offered within the Film Studies Minor (117140) or Major (117120). • Candidates for the Postgraduate exchange program do not have access to seminars CIN6053A, CIN6054A, CIN7001A and HAR60011-60012 which are reserved to regular students of the Department of Art History and Film Studies. Please note that only a one-term exchange is possible for Master and PhD Film studies programs. • Students whose first language is not French must present a certificate of proficiency corresponding to level B2 of the Common European Framework, or its equivalent, with a writing and speaking production of at least 15/25.
Department of Biology	Due to the high number of applications received each year, candidate selection is competitive. Only applicants with an above-average academic record may be selected.

<p>Department of Linguistics and Translation</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For the following programs : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Bachelor in Translation (118510) - Major in Translation (118520) - Bachelor in French Literature and Linguistics (114715) - Master in Linguistics (218010) - Master in Translation – Research (218511) - PhD in Linguistique (318010) - PhD in Translation (318510) <p>Students whose first language is not French must provide proof of TFI (Test de français International) for their knowledge of the French language level. A score of 785/990 is required. DALF or TEF with a certificate of proficiency corresponding to level C1 of the Common European Framework, or its equivalent is also accepted.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For the Master in Translation (218511) : students must provide a proof of DAL or TEF with a certificate of proficiency corresponding to level C2. • For the Master (218511) and PhD (318510) in Translation : a good level of English is required.
<p>Department of French Language Literatures</p>	<p>Students whose first language is not French must present a certificate of proficiency corresponding to level C1 for Undergraduate degree students and level C2 for the Graduate degree students of the Common European Framework, or its equivalent.</p>
<p>Department de Psychology</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Due to the high number of applications received each year, candidate selection is competitive. Only applicants with an above-average academic record may be selected. • The Department of Psychology accepts only a limited number of students enrolling to Master's or PhD courses. • The following modules are closed to exchange students : PSY1048, PSY1049, PSY2007, PSY2008, PSY2038, PSY3008, PSY3018, PSY3129, PSY3298, PSY3299, PSY40001 et PSY40002. • Internships are not offered.
<p>Department of Literatures and Languages of the World – English Studies</p>	<p>Students applying to the Bachelor must present a certificate of proficiency corresponding to B1.2 of British Council English Level or its equivalent.</p>
<p>Department of Economic Sciences</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Due to the high number of applications received each year, candidate selection is competitive. Only applicants with an above-average academic record may be selected. • Students whose first language is not French must present a certificate of proficiency of the Common European Framework. • Students must take at least 3 modules of Economic Sciences during each term. • Students may follow a maximum of one language course.

School of Psychoeducation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Due to the high number of applications received each year, candidate selection is competitive. Only applicants with an above-average academic record may be selected. • Internships are not offered. • For Master degree courses, privileged students have a diploma of Undergraduate level (or equivalent) from Psychology or Criminology background. • Students whose first language is not French must submit a French language evaluation corresponding to level B2 according to the Common European Framework which includes their level of written and oral French.
School of Criminology	<p>The School of Criminology does not accept exchange students for internships and imposes several restrictions for exchange students. Please refer to the following document (only in French).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please indicate in your cover letter: your overall average and the level of education in which you will be enrolled in your home institution when you start your exchange in Montreal.
School of Industrial Relations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only Undergraduate level or Master level candidates in Industrial Relations or related field will be considered. • One or two Master degree courses can be taken only under the academic advisor's recommendation. • Candidates whose first language is not French must present a certificate of proficiency corresponding to level C1 of the Common European Framework, or its equivalent. • The number of places in exchange programs is limited and only candidates above 12/20 or equivalent will be accepted. • Note that PhD programs are closed to exchange students, with the exception of the research credits students.
School of Social Work	<p>The School accepts limited exchange students and availability is negotiated in advance with partners (only students from universities that are partners with the School of Social Work can apply).</p>
Department of Chemistry	<p>Due to the high number of applications received each year, candidate selection is competitive. Only applicants with an above-average academic record may be selected.</p>
Master in Museology	<p>These courses are not opened to exchanges students:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - MSL6600 Internship - MSL6800 Overview seminar - MSL6700 Working group led by a professor <p><i>Students from École du Louvre are not subject to this restriction.</i></p>

Faculty of Music

- Students whose French is not the first language must provide proof of TFI (Test de français International). A score of 605/990 is required.
- There are 3 types of teaching at the Faculty of Music:
 1. Individual (instrument and composition)
 2. Small groups (chamber music, composition workshops, etc.)
 3. Lectures and large ensembles.
- **All individual courses (instrument and composition) and combo jazz ensembles** are not open to exchange students, unless applications come from our privileged partners, the level of the applicants meets our requirements and upon availabilities.

- Students who wish to register for instrumental workshops must provide an audio or video recording with their application.

Faculty of Veterinary Medicine

DVM	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The School of Veterinary Medicine only accepts students from partner universities with whom an agreement has been signed.• Student exchange programs only apply to clinical placements and 3rd year studies, no student will be admitted to other levels of study.• The School will only admit 10 students per semester (fall or winter) for clinical placements.
Master and PhD programs	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The School of Veterinary Medicine accepts only students from universities with which it has signed specific bilateral agreements.• The School welcomes students in its research, internship and residency programs.• Students wishing to participate in the student exchange program will have to obtain prior authorizations from a UdeM Veterinary Medicine professor before sending an application.

Faculty of Education

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The number of places is very limited for the Bachelor's degree in Physical and Health Education.• Students whose first language is not French must present a certificate of knowledge of the language minimally corresponding to 785/990 level to the International French test.• Candidates for undergraduate programs must have completed at least one year in their Bachelor.• Internships are not offered.• Deadline to submit an application for the winter semester: June 1st
Department of Administration and Educational Foundations	Students whose first language is not French must present a certificate of proficiency corresponding to level B2 of the Common European Framework, or its equivalent.

Faculty of Medicine	
School of Orthophony and Audiology	Places are very limited for the undergraduate degree in Orthophony and depend on the number of outgoing students.
School of Kinesiology and Physical Activity Studies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Due to the high number of applications received each year, candidate selection is competitive. Only applicants with an above-average academic record may be selected. • Students whose first language is not French must present a certificate of proficiency corresponding to level C1 of the Common European Framework, or its equivalent. • Undergraduate and Master's students are required to have completed at least the first year of their degree in order to be considered. • Internships are not offered.
Department of Nutrition	<p>For the Bachelor's degree :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The number of places in exchange program is limited and only candidates above the average will be accepted. • Students whose first language is not French must present a certificate of knowledge of the language minimally corresponding to 850/990 level to the International French test. • Bachelor's degree candidates must have completed at least the first year of their studies program. • Only courses from Undergraduate degree level can be chosen. • Internships are not offered.
School of Rehabilitation (School includes programs of Occupational Therapy and Physiotherapy)	<p>For the Bachelor and Master's degrees in Ergotherapy :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The School welcomes students from universities with which specific bilateral agreements are signed. • Students whose first language is not French must present a certificate of knowledge of the language minimally corresponding to 785/990 level to the International French test. • Bachelor's degree candidates can only do an exchange at their 3rd Bachelor's year in winter semester. • The School accepts a very limited number of exchange students. • Preliminary online modules may be required before the beginning of courses.

Faculty of Nursing

- Due to the high number of applications received each year, candidate selection is competitive. Only applicants with an above-average academic record may be selected.
- Undergraduate students can ask to be enrolled to only one of the following modules in the 3rd year of Bachelor : SOI3604A /3604B / 3704 or SOI3516/3716.
- Candidates whose first language is not French must present a certificate of knowledge of the language minimally corresponding to 785/990 level to the International French test, with a minimum score of 4 for the writing component.
