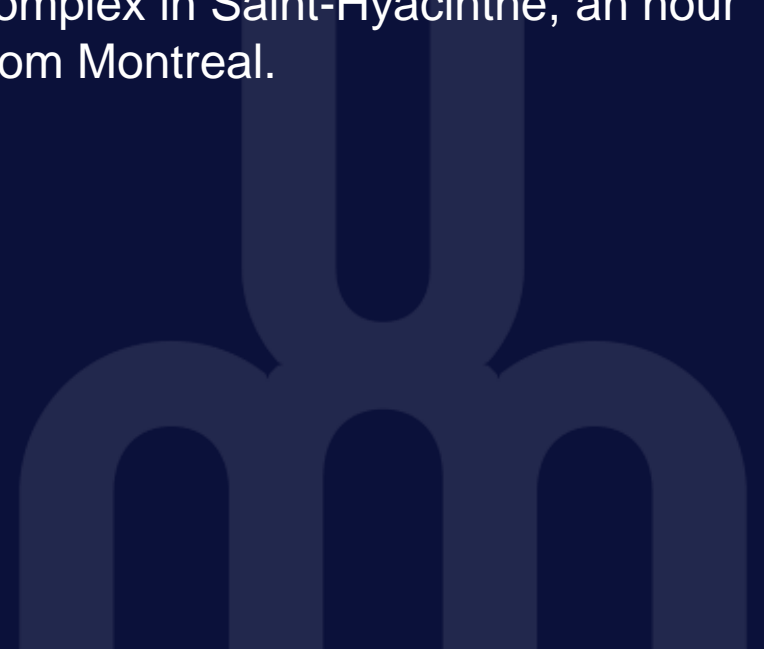

Saint- Hyacinthe campus

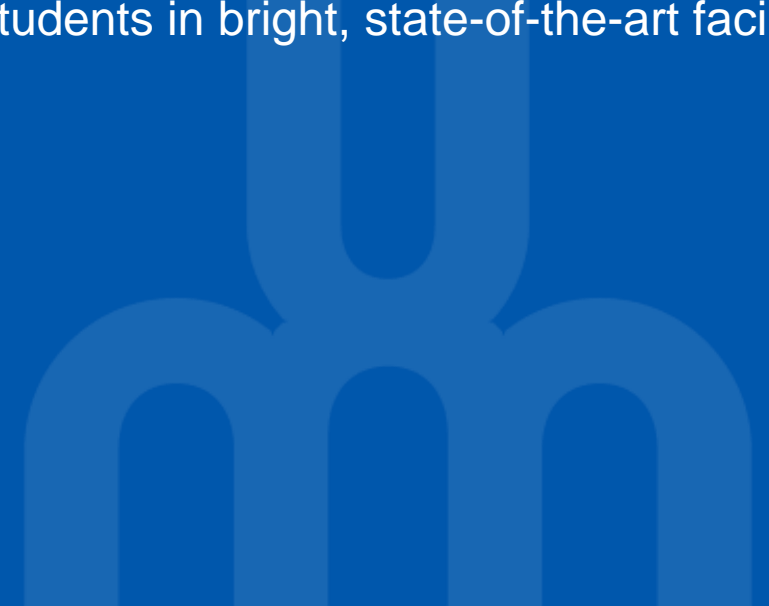
We train veterinarians at a major public-health, agri-food and biotechnology complex in Saint-Hyacinthe, an hour from Montreal.





Brossard campus

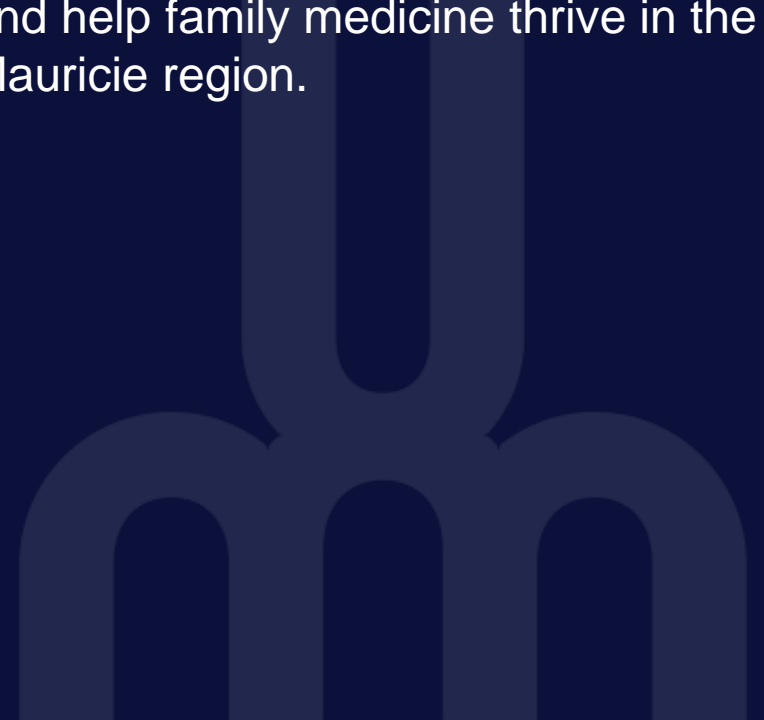
Directly connected to the REM transit system, this brand-new campus on Montreal's South Shore welcomes students in bright, state-of-the-art facilities.

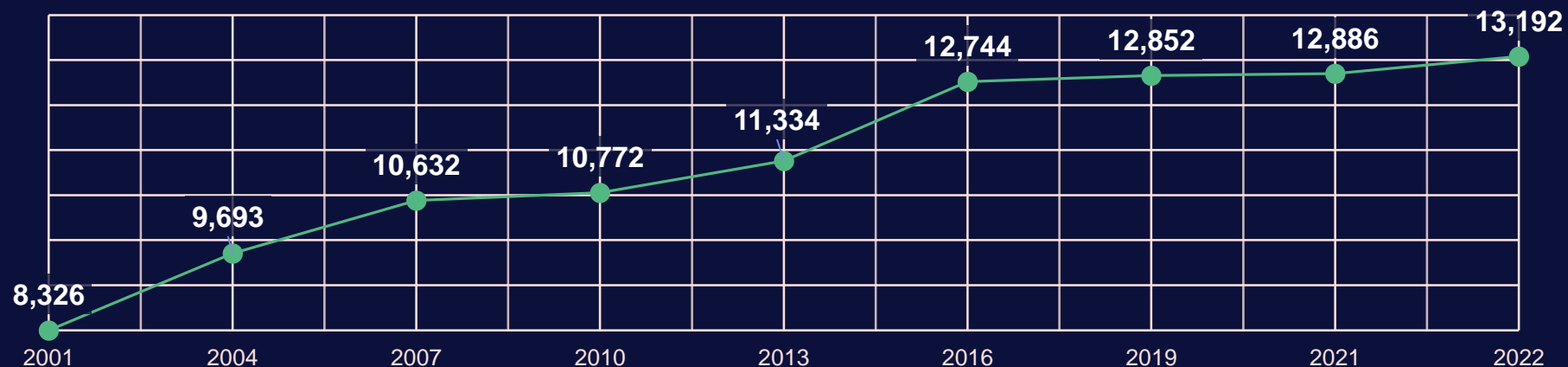

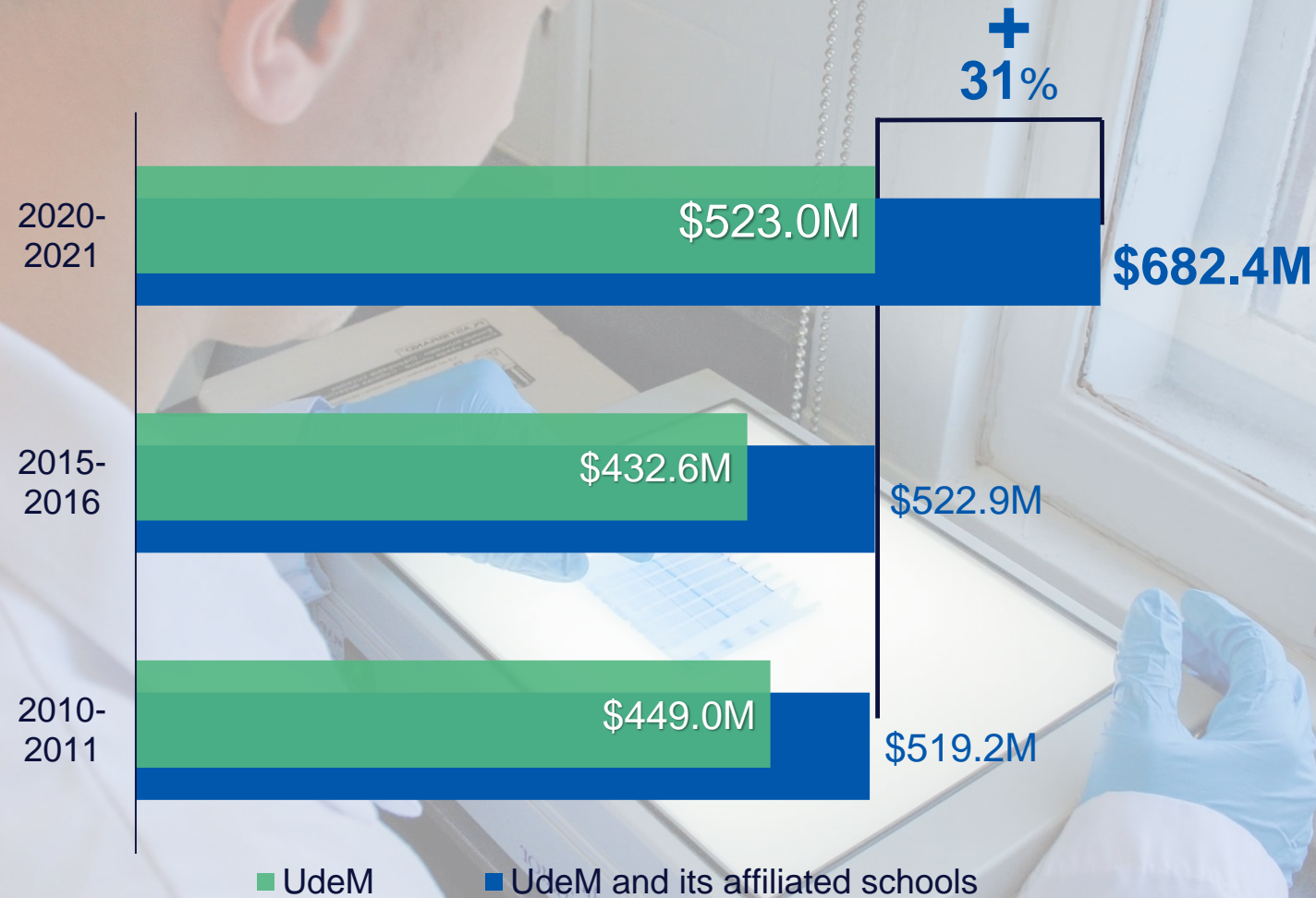
